We are looking for a skilled, creative, and collaborative Dementia Empowerment Facilitator to join our team. This person will foster and co-facilitate the on-going development of an Engagement & Empowerment Group comprised of people living with dementia in Hamilton. This group has three core functions; 1) peer support and mutual aid, 2) self-directed localized projects aimed at increasing awareness of dementia and reducing stigma about the disease in the general public, and 3) consultations on programs, policies and practices that affect people living with dementia.

This is an eighteen (18) month contract position, averaging up to 15 hours per week. The HCoA is an equal opportunity employer, and we are dedicated to building a workforce that reflects the diversity of our communities in which we live and serve.
